## PGA ASSOCIATE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINE & APPLICATION

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Dear NCPGA Associate,

On behalf of the Northern California PGA Foundation, we are pleased to send you this guideline and application for a PGM Scholarship. The NCPGA Foundation has set up funds for PGA Associates located within the Northern California Section to assist you in your pursuit of membership in the PGA of America.

Applicants must be an NCPGA Associate in good standing with plans to continue pursuit of Class “A” membership in the PGA of America, and show a sincere desire and willingness to continue their education.

**Listed below are the minimum criteria that each award will be based on:**

1. Have completed “Level 1” of the PGM Program.
2. Years associated with the Northern California Section.
3. Essay Questions.
4. Financial need.

**Along with your application, the following information is needed:**

1. Typed Response to Essay Questions.
2. Two letters of recommendation from professionals within the golf industry.
3. An interview may be requested.

The number and amount of scholarships will be based upon availability of funds and at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. These scholarships are for Associates progressing through Level 2 or Level 3 towards PGA Class A certification. Applicants may re-apply. The scholarships will be paid directly to the Associate to help with costs associated with the PGA of America PGM program. NCPGA Foundation employees and their immediate families may not participate in this scholarship program.
